



Work Safety Alert Fall from a Lorry-mounted Crane

1. Date of Accident: December 2012

2. Place of Accident: A depot in Yuen Long

3. Summary:

A worker fell from the deck of a lorry-mounted crane to the ground and later passed away.

4. Work Safety Alert for Owners/Contractors:

The owner of a lorry-mounted crane and the contractor responsible for any lifting operation involving the use of such crane should:

- conduct risk assessments and formulate safe working procedures for the lifting operation;
- ensure workers use proper and safe means of access to and egress from the deck of the lorry-mounted crane;
- as far as practicable avoid any person staying on the deck of the lorry-mounted crane while the crane is in use; otherwise ensure any jib movement and lifting/lowering operation do not endanger the person;
- station a signaler to give effective signals to the crane operator who does not have a clear and unrestricted view of its vicinity; and
- exercise adequate supervision to ensure that the above safety precautionary measures are strictly followed.
