



Work Safety Alert Struck by a Lorry

- 1. Date of Accident : October 2015
- 2. Place of Accident : A building construction site

3. Summary :

A worker was struck to death by a lorry at the entrance of a building construction site.

4. Work Safety Alert for Contractors/Employers :

To prevent any workers from being endangered by vehicles on construction sites, contractors/ employers should:

- appoint a competent person to conduct task-specific risk assessments with due regard to the site layout, traffic routes, work environment and movement of workers within the site;
- formulate and implement an effective traffic management system which should include, but not limited to, the followings :
 - segregating pedestrians from the routes for vehicles by suitable barriers in particular where space is limited or traffic is heavy such as the site entrance;
 - displaying notices requiring pedestrians to use the designated walkways at prominent locations and exercising strict access control measures to avoid unauthorized man-entry into the traffic routes;





- imposing speed limits on traffic routes through erecting speed limit signs and installing road humps or other similar devices;
- stationing a signaler to give effective signals to vehicles drivers who do not have a clear and unrestricted view of its vicinity;
- ensuring that the signaler who guides vehicles is wearing a high visibility or reflective vest; and
- ensuring that the vehicle travelling on construction site is only operated by a person who holds a valid driving licence of the class to which the vehicle belongs;
- provide all workers with adequate information, instruction and training in respect of the traffic management system of the site; and
- develop and implement an effective monitoring and control system to ensure that the above safety measures are strictly followed.
