² According to section 44A of the Trade Unions Ordinance, “relevant professional organization”, in relation to a registered trade union federation, means an organization the objects of which are to promote the interests of persons engaged or employed in a trade, industry or occupation that is the same as, or similar to, the trade, industry or occupation with which the trade union federation is directly concerned.

³ According to section 50A of the Trade Unions Ordinance, provision of false or misleading information is subject to a fine of \$100,000 and imprisonment for 6 months on summary conviction; or a fine of \$200,000 and imprisonment for 1 year on conviction on indictment.
