<sup>1</sup> According to section 50A of the Trade Unions Ordinance, provision of false or misleading information is subject to a fine of \$100,000 and imprisonment for 6 months on summary conviction; or a fine of \$200,000 and imprisonment for 1 year on conviction on indictment.

If an officer is convicted during the legal proceedings, the officer must further notify the Registrar of Trade Unions of the conviction, even though the officer has served a written notice on being charged with the specified offence(s).
