



Work Safety Alert Workers Injured in an Underground Sewage Facility

1. Date of Accident : November 2021

2. Place of Accident: An underground sewage facility

3. Summary:

Four workers conducting drainage pipe maintenance were collapsed, resulting in one death and three injured.

4. Work Safety Alert for Contractors/Proprietors/Employers:

Workers working inside an underground sewage facility may be exposed to various risks relating to confined space work. Contractors/proprietors/employers undertaking drainage work at underground sewage facility should follow the <u>Factories and Industrial Undertakings (Confined Spaces) Regulation¹, Code of Practice for Safety and Health at Work in Confined Spaces¹, and relevant safety and health guidelines, to ensure the safety and health of workers while working inside the confined space.</u>
