



Work Safety Alert Struck by a Fallen Solar Panel

- 1. Date of Accident : March 2021
- 2. Place of Accident : A two-storey house under renovation

3. Summary :

While a solar panel was being lowered manually by means of a rope from 2/F of a two-storey house to the ground floor, the panel suddenly slipped off, rebounded upon hitting the ground and struck against a worker nearby. The worker sustained serious head injury and passed away ten days later in the hospital.

4. Work Safety Alert for Contractors/ Employers :

To prevent any workers/ employees from being struck by any falling object during a lifting operation, the contractor/ employer responsible for the work should:

- appoint a competent person to conduct task-specific risk assessments to identify all potential hazards associated with the lifting operation, taking into account the size, shape and weight of the loads, the rigging method suitable for the loads to be lifted and the working environment, particularly the hazard of falling objects;
- formulate a lifting plan with due consideration to the risk assessment's results, including the selection and use of a suitable lifting appliance/ lifting gear as well as the competence of the workers/ employees involved;
- where lifting appliance is involved in the operation, appoint a competent and experienced lifting supervisor to oversee the lifting operation to ensure that all risks are effectively managed;
- ensure that the load is properly secured to prevent unintended





movement/ displacement in the course of operations;

- ensure the safety of all workers/ employees involved and other persons who may be affected by the lifting operation, including the proper fencing off of all lifting zones with suitable warning notices displayed as far as reasonably practicable;
- where it is not reasonably practicable to fence off the lifting zones, take effective measures, such as appointment of sufficient watch-out personnel, to ensure that no unauthorised entry into the zones;
- provide each worker/ employee involved in the work with a suitable safety helmet equipped with a chin strap and ensure the proper wearing of the same by the worker/ employee throughout the work;
- provide all workers/ employees concerned with the necessary safety information, instruction and training, and ensure that they are familiar with the safe work procedures and safety measures; and
- establish and implement an effective monitoring and control system to ensure all safety measures are strictly followed.
